Organised parties are invited to join a Heart of England Tourist Board registered Vale of Evesham Tour Guide for a sixty minute walking tour of historic Evesham.

The tour departs from Hampton Ferry, a fully operational hand drawn ferry, placed at the end of Boat Lane by the monks of Evesham Abbey in the thirteenth century. There is plenty of car and coach parling at Hampton Ferry. Tea and coffee will be served before the tour begins.

The tour will take us through the heart of the town, past The Almonry Museum, The Market Square, the statue of Eof,



The Town Hall, Saint Lawrances Church, All Saints Church, The Bell Tower and the beautiful Abbey Park.

From Abbey Park we join the Handsam Boat Company's 'Handsam Too' a sixty seater pleasure cruiser. Sail along Shakespeare's Avon for a thirty minute ride back to Hampton Ferry for lunch, high tea or an evening meal at Raphael's Restaurant.



The award winning Raphael's Restaurant is a modern, pleasant building with full bar facilities overlooking the River Avon. Tables will be reserved for parties on the tour and a choice of menus are available to suit your tastes and the time

Useful Information

The Guided Walk

The walk lasts approximately sixty minutes and is across flat ground, with some inclines from Hampton Ferry to the town centre and from Abbey Park to the boat. Assistance may be needed for some when boarding and disembarking the Handsam Too. The guided walk may not be suitable for very young children.

The Handsam Too

The Handsam Too was fully restored following devastating floods in July 2007. The river cruise lasts approximately thirty minutes, maximum capacity is sixty persons, wheelchair access may be restricted. For further details regarding the boat facilities telephone: 07860 895416 (mobile).

Raphael's Restaurant

Raphael's is a licenced restaurant with indoor seating capacity for sixty. The restaurant has a wheelchair access ramp, but does not yet have wheelchair accessible toilets.

Wheelchair Hire

We are now able to provide a wheelchair hire service through the charity 'shopmobility'. A donation to the charity of around £5 will hire a chair for the day. Electric chairs and shopping scooters are also available (further fees may apply). We will gladly arrange hire for you and collect and return the equipment as appropriate.
